

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLECTION BREAST/NIPPLE DISCHARGE

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Frosted end glass slides Fixative (95% alcohol or cytology spray fixative)

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Express the secretion by gently compressing the areolar area between the thumb and index finger, first vertically, then in a clockwise direction to include the total area. When a mass is palpable, gently milk the space between the mass and the areolar area before expressing the secretion.
- 2. Smear the secretion lengthwise onto a clean glass slide and place immediately in 95% alcohol or spray with fixative. If spraying with fixative take care to hold the slide no closer than 8-10 inches away while covering with one layer of fixative.
- 3. If the secretion is thick use another clean glass slide to spread the material more evenly.
- 4. Representative cells of the lesion may not be present on all the preparations. Prepare as many slides as possible from the entire secretion and number the slides sequentially.
- 5. If possible, prepare at least one air-dried smear in addition to the alcohol-fixed smears.
