



Fetal Chromosome Analysis Collection Instructions

- 1. Products of conception that are sent to Physicians Laboratory for chromosome analysis must be accompanied by a signed "Disposition of Fetal Remains" form. Forms can be found on this website under the Client Services tab Request and Consent Forms and are downloadable.
- 2. Do NOT place the specimen in formalin. Send it fresh wrapped in saline-moistened gauze on cold packs. If transportation is going to be delayed place it in the refrigerator until pickup. Notify Physicians Laboratory Client Services at 605-322-7212.
- 3. Alternatively, the physician may place some of the specimen in basal media (provided by Physicians Laboratory). This is especially helpful if there is a delay in specimen delivery. Requirements for proper processing are any of the following:
 - a. Villi of placenta (10-20mg)

b. 50-100mg of solid fetal tissue which may consist of solid organs, muscle or diaphragm. Use sterile technique and close the tube tightly.

- 4. Any leftover tissue specimen may be submitted in formalin for the usual pathology analysis.
- 5. Fill out a Physicians Laboratory surgical requisition with the usual information. Be sure to include any pertinent family history.
- 6. If the patient requests that the fetus be returned for burial it should NOT be placed in formalin.
